Materials: 4 skeins of [Louisa Harding Nautical Cotton](#) yarn; beads & beading needle (included in \$15 accessory kit); US size H crochet hook; scissors/yarn cutter. **Undulating Waves Scarf** 1 - 4 PM Sunday 17 February 2008 \$30 + \$15 accessory kit (includes pattern, beads, Big Eye needle)

The Undulating Wave Scarf pattern designed specifically for "[Susan](#)" yarn by [Schaefer](#) is mesmerizing as the wave pattern crests with shimmering beads. This is a wonderful class for advanced knitters to learn how to incorporate beads into their fine knitting. Materials: 1 skein "[Susan](#)" yarn; US size #6 knitting needles; scissors/thread snips. (Instructor [Judy Thacker](#)) Skill Level: **Experienced**

Knit just 1 generous skein of mohair, silk, and wool into an openwork triangular shawl with deep, gorgeous fringe. Learn a bind off that is very stretchy, and how to apply and knot the fringe. Materials: 1 skein [The Rockies](#); 1 skein matching [Baby Kid Mohair](#); US size #10 or 10.5 circular knitting needles 24" or 32" long; scissors/yarn cutter. (Instructor [Liz Knapp](#)) Skill Level: **Easy** (ability to read a pattern, cast on, knit and YO)
